Safeguarding Vulnerable Children on Transport Networks

Monday 29 January marked the start of two weeks of action in Braintree to raise awareness of the vulnerability of young people to exploitation and abuse at stations and transport networks.

Research and local data have shown transport networks are used by vulnerable young people who may be at risk of child sexual exploitation, child criminal exploitation and trafficking. Young people often gravitate towards stations because they are busy, anonymous places that also provide some form of shelter and access to food and drink. A young person may use a station or public transport as a way to try to disappear. Bus and rail networks can also be used by offenders to traffic young people for the purpose of sexual and criminal exploitation.

Providing essential services for an extra 10p per week

Maintaining and investing in essential services alongside a small rise in council tax will be up for discussion at a Cabinet meeting on Monday 5th February.

A further reduction in central government funding combined with increasing demand for services and increases in inflation means the Council is proposing to increase Council Tax for only the third time in eight years.

As part of Braintree District Council's budget proposals for 2018/19, the proposal to increase Council Tax by 2.97% equates to an extra 10p per week and will support the delivery of vital services such as refuse and recycling collections, parks and open spaces and street cleaning.
